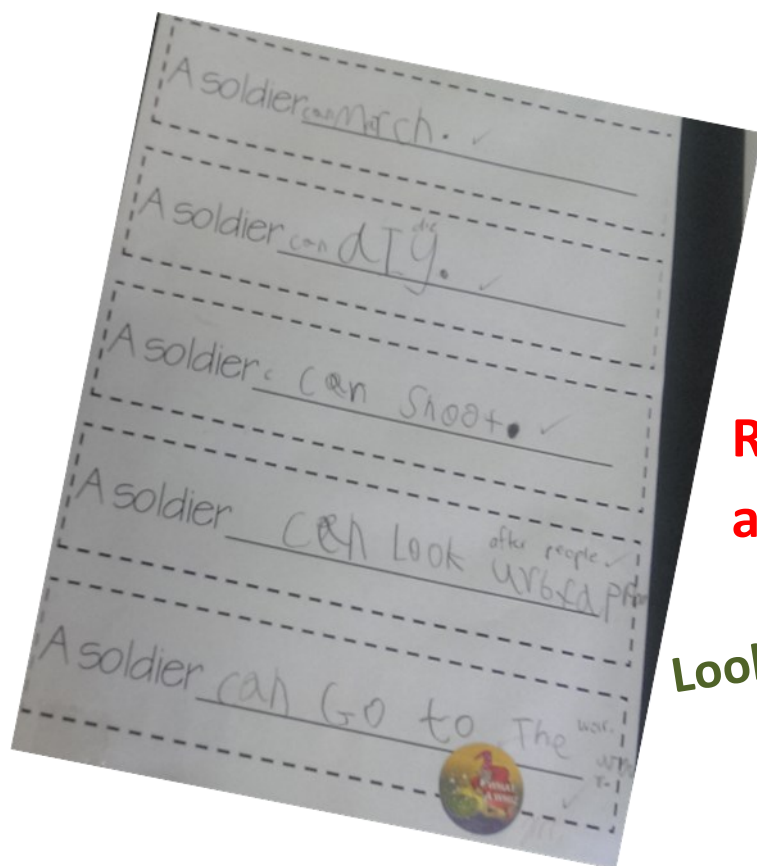

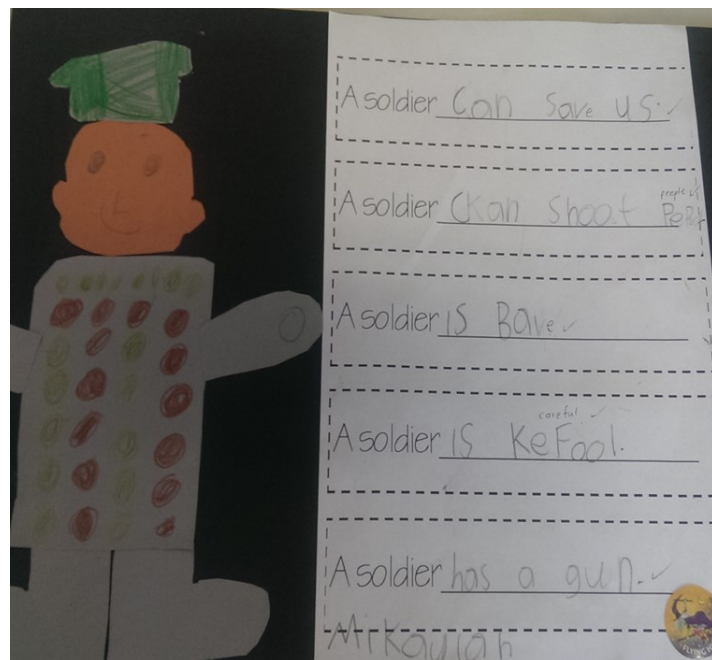
Our ANZAC WALT (We Are Learning To...)
